Signs	Description of Actions
best	Touch lips with the fingertips of the right flat hand (fingers together.) Then move the hand across the lips and to the right of the head, ending in the "a" hand position above head level. Note: This sign's meaning comes from the association of giving something a taste and then affirming something good with a "thumbs-up."
bright	Touch the right middle fingertip to the back of the left "s" hand (palm turned downward). Then lift the right hand upward while gently shaking all fingers as if sprinkling glitter.
