Fill in the blank exercises for repeated addition and multiplication.

1.  $3 + \underline{\quad} + 3 = 3 \times 3 = 9$

2.  $4 + \underline{\quad} + \underline{\quad} = 4 \times 3 = 12$

3.  $\underline{\quad} + \underline{\quad} + 2 = 2 \times 3 = 6$

4.  $5 + 5 + 5 = \underline{\quad} \times 3 = 15$
