| Trachea | • | • Tiny air sacs where oxygen and carbon dioxide are exchanged with the blood. |
| Lungs | • | • The space behind the nose that filters, warms, and moistens air before it enters the lungs. |
| Bronchi | • | • Branches off the trachea that lead to each lung. |
| Diaphragm | • | • A dome-shaped muscle that helps in breathing by contracting and relaxing. |
| Alveoli | • | • The structure containing vocal cords, also called the voice box. |
| Nasal Cavity | • | • The main organs of the respiratory system where gas exchange takes place. |
| Pharynx | • | • The passage behind the nose and mouth that connects to the esophagus and larynx. |
| Larynx | • | • A tube that connects the throat to the lungs; also known as the windpipe. |
